The mission of the legal assistance program is to assist eligible clients with their personal legal affairs in a timely and professional manner.

Legal assistance attorneys offer legal counseling, legal negotiation, and referrals to other professionals. Eligible clients should contact their local legal assistance office to schedule an appointment to discuss their personal needs. In addition to providing legal counsel, the legal assistance attorneys can assist the client to access resources available from the American Bar Association (ABA).

Legal assistance attorneys advise on a variety of cases, to include special education law, estate planning, family law, and civilian administrative. Military legal assistance services have partnered with the ABA's military section to connect eligible clients with civilian practitioners (pro bono – free of charge) where the military legal assistance attorney's ability to help is limited.
