On July 16, 2020, Commissioner Diaz and the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners unanimously approved a total of \$20 million in federal CARES Act funding to develop programs to assist veterans and active military with housing, basic needs assistance and small business grants.

BASIC NEEDS PROGRAM

The Basic Needs Program assists eligible households with \$1,000 of basic needs assistance vouchers for single applicants and \$2,000 of basic needs assistance vouchers for households of two or more. Vouchers can be used to purchase groceries, medical supplies, baby and adult care products, and other household items.

HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Housing Program provides up to three months of past due rent or mortgage payments per household, with a maximum of \$5,000 per household. Funds will be paid to the landlord or mortgage lender in the form of a grant by Miami-Dade County.

VETERANS BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM

The Veterans Business Grant (VBG) Program is for qualifying veterans who own businesses and have experienced financial hardships due to COVID-19. Funding received will be calculated based on individual percentages of eligible costs incurred, with a maximum award of \$25,000 per business.
